

IMPORTANT

- 1. In order to weigh accurately, the supporting legs should be on flat ground and the weight scale facing up in a vertical position. Make sure the item being weighed is not touching the Prepstand.
- 2. Accuracy tolerance of this weight scale is ± 20 grams. When the weight scale is not facing up in a vertical position, the error tolerance will increase. Reposition the scale to face up a vertical position and reset the unit by pressing the reset button (%)
- 3. Measured data from the Topeak weight scale is for personal reference only and cannot be used for other purposes.
